It is desirable, not required, that candidates have achieved CMC or NCCMC designation. Officers serve one-year terms. Second Vice President succeeds to First Vice President, then to President, and then to Immediate Past President.

Requirements: Candidates must be an active member of NCAMC for at least three (3) years. It is desirable, not required, that candidates have achieved CMC or NCCMC designation. Officers serve one-year terms. Recording Secretary is not in the secession plan for the Presidency of the NCAMC.

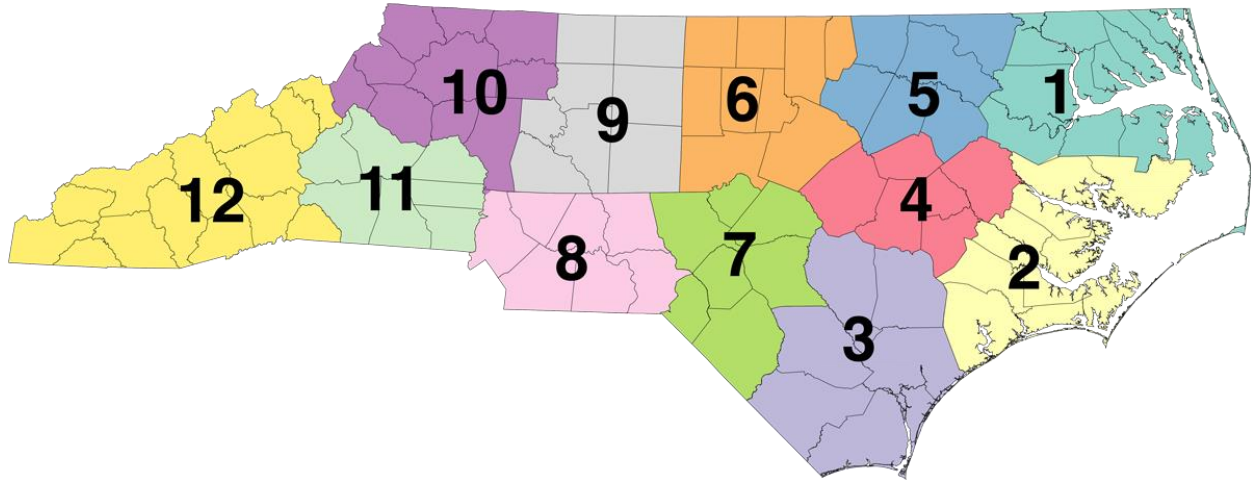

The North Carolina League of Municipalities divides the State into 12 Districts by county as follows.

Region 1

District I: Bertie, Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Dare, Gates, Hertford, Martin, Pasquotank, Perquimans, Tyrrell, and Washington

District II: Beaufort, Carteret, Craven, Hyde, Jones, Onslow and Pamlico

District III: Bladen, Brunswick, Columbus, Duplin, New Hanover, Pender, and Sampson

Region 2

District IV: Green, Johnston, Lenoir, Pitt, Wayne, and Wilson

District V: Edgecombe, Franklin, Halifax, Nash, Northampton and Warren

District VI: Alamance, Caswell, Chatham, Durham, Granville, Orange, Person, Vance, and Wake

Region 3

District VII: Cumberland, Harnett, Hoke, Lee, Moore, Robeson, and Scotland

District VIII: Anson, Cabarrus, Mecklenburg, Montgomery, Richmond, Stanly, and Union

District IX: Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Guilford, Randolph, Rockingham, Rowan, and Stokes

Region 4

District X: Alexander, Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Caldwell, Iredell, Surry, Watauga, Wilkes, and Yadkin

District XI: Burke, Catawba, Cleveland, Gaston, Lincoln, McDowell, and Rutherford

District XII: Buncombe, Cherokee, Clay, Graham, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Macon, Madison, Mitchell, Polk, Swain, Transylvania, and Yancey
